Injury Cause:	Employee was using welder at chest height. Sparks ignited and burned through both shirts, burning chest and shoulder/arm
Action Taken to Prevent Reoccurrence:	The accident investigation revealed employee was not wearing proper PPE (welding jacket) completely outside the scope of company policy and safety training. Employee remained off work for 2 days before returning to work with new welding jacket. Employee was counseled and retrained.
