Every accident/incident will be investigated regardless of the extent of injuries. Even a near miss or minor injury can give you causes that may stop a more serious accident from occurring in the future. Your experienced based recommendations and ideas for prevention of such an accident are welcomed and **needed**.

I. Injury Summary:

Date Of Injury:	March 3, 2011
Date Reported:	March 4, 2011
Injury Type:	Right Knee Sprain
Injury Cause:	Employee had just lifted product out of a kettle, turned and started to walk when employee ran into a pipe sticking out of cabinet. Right knee hit the pipe spraining the knee.
Action Taken to Prevent Reoccurrence:	The accident investigation revealed the pipe was part of an old shelf that was never removed. This accident could have caused a much more severe injury. Correction: The pipe was removed and the department was re-trained on reporting hazards for correction.
