Every accident/incident will be investigated regardless of the extent of injuries. Even a near miss or minor injury can give you causes that may stop a more serious accident from occurring in the future. Your experienced based recommendations and ideas for prevention of such an accident are welcomed and **needed**.

I. Injury Summary:

Date Of Injury:	January 3, 2010
Date Reported:	January 4, 2010
Injury Type:	Slip and fall
Injury Cause:	Employee had just gotten out of truck at job site and ground was uneven and muddy, employee slipped fell straining right shoulder when he put his arm down to catch his fall.
Action Taken to Prevent Reoccurrence:	The accident investigation revealed employee was preoccupied and was not been paying attention to his surroundings. This is one of those unforeseen conditions that remind everyone to be mentally and physically ready for work, especially in safety sensitive work environments. Injury could have easily been much worse.
