Injury Type:	Multiple injuries to R ankle and foot

Injury Cause:	Employee was shrink wrapping load outside storage room when he was struck by another employee driving a forklift load into the storage room. Employee became trapped under load. Driver was stopped and employee pulled from under load. Sprained R ankle with contusions and abrasions to foot and was given 2 days off with restrictions when he returned to work. Driver states he did not see employee working near by and injured employee did not alert driver to his presence.
Action Taken to Prevent Reoccurrence:	The accident investigation reveled forklift driver was operating forklift in the wrong direction for the size of the load. Both employees received safety retraining. Lines were painted to identify forklift traffic areas. It was also identified the area of the accident is very congested and plans have begun to open the area to allow for freer movement without further injury.
