The following DOSH/OSHA Recordable has occurred. In an effort to prevent similar injuries from occurring at your location, please review the injury summary shown below. Remember that a Supervisor's Incident Report is to be completed and faxed to ERNWest, within 24 hours of notification of the incident. Every accident/incident will be investigated regardless of the extent of injuries. Even a near miss or minor injury can give you causes that may stop a more serious accident from occurring in the future. Your experienced based recommendations and ideas for prevention of such an accident are welcomed and **needed**.

**I. Injury Summary:**

<b>Date Of Injury:</b>	April 14, 2010
<b>Date Reported:</b>	April 15, 2010
<b>Injury Type:</b>	R shoulder strain & R elbow contusion
<b>Injury Cause:</b>	Employee strained R shoulder and R elbow from slipping and falling on ice in freezer. Employee given light duty for 5 days.
<b>Action Taken to Prevent Reoccurrence:</b>	The accident investigation revealed the freezer door was being left open for long periods of time and the door seal is severally damaged from pallet jack hitting door. The safety committee has recommended using plastic curtains to hold in cold air and the door will be repaired. The condensation had built up on floor causing a dangerous risk for slips.
