Injury Type:	Left Shoulder contusion
Injury Cause:	Employee bruised left shoulder when he pulled on bailer chain, broke and struck him on the left shoulder.
Action Taken to Prevent Reoccurrence:	The accident investigation revealed the chain connection broke when employee applied downward pulling pressure and bruised left shoulder. Company will adhere to stricter (more frequent) maintenance of equipment.
