<b>Injury Cause:</b>	<p>48 year old roofer was working as a safety monitor on the North East Corner of building roof. Employee was not supposed to be doing anything but monitoring employees outside fall protection zone. Employee decided to walk away from monitoring station and picked up a piece of debris to move it away from area. Employee stepped on a section of bad decking, and the deck gave away causing the employee to fall 11ft below. Fall protection plan was being followed; however employee deviated away from job duties.</p> <p>911 was called and employee was transported to Auburn Regency Medical Center for evaluation. Employee sustained major injuries to his upper and lower back and was placed on lost time for 45 days. He is currently receiving treatment for his injuries.</p>
<b>Action Taken to Prevent Reoccurrence:</b>	Starting 9-26 supervisors will hold one-on-one meetings with designated safety monitors to explain their job duties; and all employees will sign off on company fall protection plan.
