Injury Cause:	Power drill caught in wood stud, spun around and hit employee in jaw. Lost 4 days of work.
Action Taken to Prevent Reoccurrence:	The accident investigation revealed employee was using corded power drill and in a positioned where he needed to hold stud and drill at the same time and could not react fast enough when bit caught and spun drill around. Investigation revealed the bit was dull and employee was in a hurry. Pushing the bit that hard was not allowing the material to clear. Employee was counseled on proper safety and tool maintenance.
