The following DOSH/OSHA Recordable has occurred. In an effort to prevent similar injuries from occurring at your location, please review the injury summary shown below. Remember that a Supervisor's Incident Report is to be completed and faxed to ERNWest, within 24 hours of notification of the incident. Every accident/incident will be investigated regardless of the extent of injuries. Even a near miss or minor injury can give you causes that may stop a more serious accident from occurring in the future. Your experienced based recommendations and ideas for prevention of such an accident are welcomed and **needed**.

<b>Date Of Injury:</b>	September 21, 2010
<b>Date Reported:</b>	September 21, 2010
<b>Injury Type:</b>	Laceration
<b>Injury Cause:</b>	Employee was cleaning the deli meat slicer when blade slipped and cut left hand requiring 3 stitches.
<b>Action Taken to Prevent Reoccurrence:</b>	The accident investigation revealed the employee was not wearing cut resistant gloves. In addition the machine was not unplugged during the cleaning. DOSH is very specific about disconnecting means during cleaning of machines. Employee was counseled on proper safety procedures.
