The following DOSH/OSHA Recordable has occurred. In an effort to prevent similar injuries from occurring at your location, please review the injury summary shown below. Remember that a Supervisor's Incident Report is to be completed and faxed to ERNWest, within 24 hours of notification of the incident. Every accident/incident will be investigated regardless of the extent of injuries. Even a near miss or minor injury can give you causes that may stop a more serious accident from occurring in the future. Your experienced based recommendations and ideas for prevention of such an accident are welcomed and **needed**.

**I. Injury Summary:**

<b>Date Of Injury:</b>	September 18,, 2009
<b>Date Reported:</b>	September 18, 2009
<b>Injury Type:</b>	Tail bone bruise
<b>Injury Cause:</b>	Employee was carrying an arm full of material. Stepped onto a piece of conduit, it rolled causing him to fall to the ground landing on tailbone.
<b>Action Taken to Prevent Reoccurrence:</b>	The accident investigation revealed that house keeping playing a major role in this accident. There is now a policy in place to address keeping materials picked and organized. The investigation also revealed the injured worker was carrying far to much material to clearly see the path in front of him. Another policy was written to address this and a material cart was purchased to aid employees in carrying materials to the job site.
