<b>Injury Cause:</b>	Employee was hole-watch monitor near confine space vessel. Employee was drinking soda next to space. Employee took a big drink and swallowed a bee. The bee stung the employee on the roof of the mouth resulting in major swelling. Employee was rushed to hospital and was given medication to reduce swelling.
<b>Action Taken to Prevent Reoccurrence:</b>	Employee did not follow safety rules and was reprimanded for not following them. Work area has lead and asbestos and food/drinks are not allowed in these work areas. Food/drink are only allowed in designated areas. Supervisors were reminded to review this with employees working in area.
