


COVID-19 & LABOR AND INDUSTRIES





IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVERAGE AND BENEFITS

Governor Jay Inslee and L&I Director Joel Sacks have announced that workers' compensation benefits will be provided to employees of assisted living and skilled nursing buildings during the time they're quarantined after being exposed to coronavirus on the job, even if they do not test positive.

- To qualify, the employee must be able to identify a specific source or event associated with the performance of their job (e.g. a positive COVID diagnoses or COVID quarantine associated with the building) that resulted in exposure to coronavirus.
- Employees who may qualify under #2 should file a claim for partial wage replacement (between 60% and 75% of regular wages depending on marital and dependent status).

FILING INSTRUCTIONS FOR EXPOSED WORKERS

- 1. Follow your workplace rules regarding a potential exposure.
- 2. From your place of quarantine file your claim online at lni.wa.gov, using File Fast or by calling 1-877-561-3453. **Write down the claim number**
- Call your medical provider or schedule a virtual visit
 with a medical provider to complete the claim filing
 process. Get your provider's fax number, L&I needs
 to contact the provider you talk to before they can
 allow payment.
